The Local Offer provides you with details of the services available in your area for children and young people between the ages 0–25 with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.



The Local Offer is...

- A single point for information on services and provisions available
- Easy to understand
- Easily accessible
- Created with and for young people, parents and professionals.

The Local Offer for Parents

The Local Offer gives details of services available for you and your child to access in your local area, for example a specialist group for you both to attend, or a parent support group.

You are able to search by category, or keywords, and filter to find services relevant to you. The school or college (if your child is already in education) will be able to show you the information about what they offer for children with SEN and disabilities



The Local Offer and Statutory Assessment

During the statutory assessment process, you can use the Local Offer to find support services such as the Information, Advice and Support Services Network (IASS) and the Parent Forum Group. You can also find information and guidance about the legislation and code of practice, SEN descriptors and more.
